

Math

Students will learn how to tell time on the hour and the half hour.

Then, we will begin Unit 8 titled "Two's, Five's and Ten's". Students will continue to work on solving addition and subtraction word problems using various strategies through the end of this unit. Following Unit 8 we will begin our unit on Place Value. In this unit students will learn the value of digits in a 2 digit number. Students will also learn how to add and subtract groups of ten from any given 2 digit number.

Please continue to practice math facts.

Science and Social Studies

In Science we will continue our unit on Earth Science: Earth Systems, Structures, and Processes, in which students learned about the physical properties of Earth Materials and the characteristics of different types of soils. NOTE: our gem mining field trip will be on April 24.
